

## Checklist of steps to make sure your comic is easy to read



Number your panels or the
elements in your panels.
Mark the start and finishing point.
Trace a line that goes over all the
elements in order to simulate the
movement of the reader's eye.
Check whether the line makes any
loops, or whether it often goes
back and forth.
Check whether there is a lot of
space between two elements. Does
the eye have to "jump"?

All panels and elements of text (bubbles, narration, etc.) should read from left to right and top to bottom as much as possible. This should also apply to manga style comics that you create.
